## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion on July 21, 2020, requesting the Commission open a file for investigation of a natural gas pipeline incident in Kansas City, Missouri. Staff's motion explains the incident occurred on July 1, 2020, along Highway 169 in an area served by Spire Missouri West. The Commission opened this file and set a deadline for Staff to file a report regarding the incident or a status report. That deadline was subsequently extended to May 28, 2021.

On May 27, 2021, Staff filed a status report stating that a Spire Missouri Inc. review of Staff's draft appendices for accuracy and Spire Missouri's review for confidential information was provided to Staff on May 26, 2021, and thus Staff requires additional time to finalize its report. Staff requests until June 28, 2021, to file its report on the incident or to file a status report. The Commission finds that the request for additional time is reasonable and will grant it.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file its report on the incident or a further status report on or before June 28, 2021.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
