## ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS

On November 10, 2010, the Commission set an evidentiary hearing for November 29. On November 12, Public Counsel requested that responses to discovery requests be expedited to conform with the short time available for discovery prior to the hearing. The reasons for the requested relief provide good cause for the Commission to expedite discovery responses in variance with the schedule established pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090. The Commission will grant Public Counsel's request.

Additionally, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources sought intervention on November 9. MDNR's request is in compliance with the Commission's intervention rule and the Commission will grant MDNR intervention.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources' request to intervene is granted.
2. The Office of the Public Counsel's motion for expedited responses to discovery is granted. The parties shall respond to data requests no later than five (5) business days after their receipt, and any objections to data requests must be made no later than three (3) business days after their receipt. These response deadlines apply to all discovery requests

made in this matter with the exception of discovery requests made prior to the issuance of this order. Discovery requests made prior to this order must be answered no later than November 17, 2010, and any objections to those requests must be made no later than November 15, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
