ORDER DIRECTING ANNUAL REPORTS

Issue Date: March 1, 2022 Effective Date: March 1, 2022

The Commission opened this gas safety investigation on January 6, 2016. The Commission's Staff filed its report regarding that investigation on May 31, 2017. In response to Staff's report, the Commission ordered Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri to file quarterly reports describing its progress in implementing certain corrective measures. In an order issued September 24, 2018, the Commission ordered Ameren Missouri to continue filing those quarterly reports until directed otherwise. Ameren Missouri has continued to file quarterly reports, the most recent on December 20, 2021.

On February 3, 2022, the Commission directed Staff and Ameren Missouri to indicate whether additional quarterly reports should be required and, if Ameren Missouri is to file further reports, what information those reports should contain. In response, Staff filed a recommendation on February 28, 2022, explaining that Ameren Missouri continues to implement a program designed to correct the problems identified by Staff regarding missing service line installation records. Staff recommends Ameren Missouri be directed to continue to file reports describing its progress in identifying and updating those records. Staff does recommend that Ameren Missouri file its progress reports annually rather than

quarterly. Further, Staff describes a revised annual reporting format. Staff represents that Ameren Missouri agrees with these revised reporting requirements.

The Commission will modify the previously ordered reporting requirements to comply with the recommendations of Staff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Ameren Missouri shall file an annual progress report, using the agreed-upon form described in Staff's pleading of February 28, 2022. Ameren Missouri shall file its initial annual report no later than March 31, 2022. Additional annual report are to be filed no later than March 31 of each subsequent year, until otherwise ordered by the Commission.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
