ORDER ESTABLISHING DOCKET
AND
DIRECTING FILING OF ACCIDENT REPORT

On January 18, 1983, the Staff of the Commission filed its "Motion For the Establishment of a Docket" herein. By its motion, the Commission Staff requests that a docket be established for the purpose of receiving the Staff Accident Report pertaining to Staff's investigation of an explosion at a commercial building at 2208 Vine Street, Kansas City, Missouri, at approximately 9:50 a.m. CST on Wednesday, January 12, 1983. Natural gas service in Kansas City is provided by The Gas Service Company.

The Commission determines that Staff's motion should be granted, and that the engineering section of the Staff should be directed to file its accident report within 120 days of the date of this order.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Case No. GS-83-236 be, and is hereby, established for the purpose of receiving the Staff Accident Report pertaining to the investigation of the explosion at 2208 Vine Street, Kansas City, Missouri, on January 12, 1983.

ORDERED: 2. That the engineering section of the Commission Staff be, and is hereby, ordered and directed to file its Staff Accident Report within one hundred twenty (120) days from the effective date of this order.

ORDERED: 3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
