## **ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On July 3, 2007, Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy, filed natural gas conservation tariff sheets. MGE filed those sheets purportedly as contemplated by the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. GR-2006-0422. The tariff sheets are due to go into effect August 3.

On July 9, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion to Suspend Tariff, claiming that the tariff sheets embody a promotional practice as defined by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-14.010(6)(L), and that the sheets do not comply with the Commission's promotional practice rule, 4 CSR 240-3.255(2)(B).

The Commission will order Staff to file a Recommendation regarding the proposed tariff, and a response to OPC's motion. Further, the Commission will allow MGE to respond to OPC's motion.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its Recommendation and response to the Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Tariff and Motion to Take Administrative Notice no later than July 25, 2007.
- 2. Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy, may respond to the Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Tariff and Motion to Take Administrative Notice no later than July 25, 2007.
  - 3. This order shall become effective on July 16, 2007.
