## ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 1, 2008, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to modify the procedural schedule for this case. Staff proposes to add a settlement conference to allow the parties to meet and discuss the possibility of settling this matter before going to hearing. Staff further proposes to extend surrebuttal testimony and issues list etc. filing dates and to reschedule the hearing from January 13-14 to January 28-29, 2009. Staff has discussed its suggested modifications with counsel for Laclede and Public Counsel and no party objects.

The Commission has considered Staff's motion. Since the parties agree to the changes, the Commission will modify the procedural schedule as Staff requests.

Staff stated that its changes should not affect the March 16, 2009 tariff suspension date; however, moving the hearing does reduce the amount of time for briefing and Commission deliberation by two weeks. Therefore, the Commission shall expedite the filing of the transcripts and shall put the parties on notice that the briefing schedule may also be shortened.

Settlement conference January 8, 2009

Joint issues list, statements of position, and order of witnesses

and cross-examination

Hearing January 28-29, 2009

January 22, 2009
