ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On May 17, 2011, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend a tariff submitted by Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy (MGE). Thus far, the Commission has taken no action on that motion, but MGE voluntarily extended the effective date of the tariff until August 10. On August 4, MGE, Staff, and Public Counsel filed a unanimous stipulation and agreement that asks the Commission to approve MGE's tariff to take effect on August 10.

The Commission will not be able to consider the unanimous stipulation and agreement until its August 10 agenda meeting. That means MGE's tariff will become effective at the start of the day on August 10, and would be effective before the Commission can consider the tariff at its agenda meeting. So that the Commission can consider the stipulation and agreement before the tariff takes effect, the Commission will suspend that tariff for a period of 10 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet, filed by Southern Union Company d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy on May 11, 2011, and assigned Tariff No. JG-2011-0565, is suspended for ten days from August 10, 2011, to August 20, 2011. The tariff sheet suspended is:
