## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On November 26, 2012, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri issued a tariff that will implement a revised natural gas energy efficiency program for 2013. Ameren Missouri's cover letter that accompanied the tariff filing represents that the Energy Efficiency Advisory Group (EEAG), which consists of the Commission's Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, does not oppose the proposed tariff. Ameren Missouri's tariff carries an effective date of January 1, 2013.

At this time, no one has asked the Commission to suspend Ameren Missouri's natural gas energy efficiency tariff and it may be that no one will oppose the tariff. However, this is an important matter and the Commission would like to hear from its Staff before either acting on the tariff or allowing it to take effect by operation of law.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's proposed natural gas energy efficiency tariff no later than December 14, 2012.
- 2. Any other party that wants to file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's proposed natural gas energy efficiency tariff shall do so no later than December 14, 2012.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
