**ORDER APPROVING ENERGY EFFICIENCY TARIFF**

Issue Date: December 19, 2012

Effective Date: January 1, 2013

On November 26, 2012, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri issued a tariff that will implement a revised natural gas energy efficiency program for 2013. Ameren Missouri's cover letter that accompanied the tariff filing represents that the Energy Efficiency Advisory Group (EEAG), which consists of the Commission's Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, does not oppose the proposed tariff. Ameren Missouri's tariff carries an effective date of January 1, 2013.

On November 27, the Commission issued an order directing its Staff to file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff. That order also required that any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding that tariff do so no later than December 14. Staff filed its recommendation to approve the tariff on December 11. No other party has filed a response to the tariff.

Staff's recommendation explains that Ameren Missouri's current energy efficiency tariff is set to expire on December 31, 2012. The new tariff, which modifies the existing residential and commercial energy efficiency programs, is needed to

replace and extend the existing programs. Staff indicates some additional analysis is needed to fully evaluate the energy efficiency measures that are implemented in the tariff but Staff does not oppose Ameren Missouri's tariff filing.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission will approve Ameren Missouri's tariff.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Ameren Missouri's natural gas energy efficiency tariff, Tariff No. JG-2013-0241, is approved to become effective on January 1, 2013. The specific tariff sheets approved are:
