ORDER REJECTING FILING AND DIRECTING ADDITIONAL FILING

On February 25, 2021, Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities purported to extend the effective date of Tariff No. YG-2021-0137 from March 15, 2021, to June 1, 2021. Liberty Utilities also filed a screenshot in the electronic file showing that the tariff's extended effective date had been successfully submitted. Extensions of the effective date of tariff submissions must, at a minimum, include a cover letter.

In particular, Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.065(6), provides:

When a public utility extends the effective date of a tariff, it shall file a letter extending the tariff effective date in the official case file. Notwithstanding any other provision of these rules, this letter may be filed by a nonattorney.

Therefore, the Commission will reject the deficient filing and order Liberty Utilities to correct the deficiency by filing a letter in accord with the Commission's rules.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Liberty Utilities' February 25, 2021 filing of a screenshot is rejected.
2. Liberty Utilities shall file a letter pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.065(6), no later than February 26, 2021.

3. This order is effective when issued.
