ORDER WAIVING NOTICE OF INTENT AND DIRECTING FILING

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Request for Waiver* ("motion") and ordering the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") to file a response to the *Staff's Response to Order* ("recommendation").

Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy ("Southern Union") filed the motion with the petition on February 22, 2011. In the motion, Southern Union seeks a waiver of the requirement¹ that any public utility to file a notice of intent before initiating an action that is likely to be a contested case. This action, in the Commission's experience, is not likely to be a contested case, so the Commission will grant the motion.

Staff filed its recommendation as to the petition on April 25, 2011, and supplemented the recommendation on April 26, 2011, so the Commission will set a date for OPC to file a response to the recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Request for Waiver of the notice of intent requirement is granted.
- 2. The Office of Public Counsel shall file a response to the *Staff's Response to Order* no later than May 5, 2011.
