RESPONSE OF KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY TO NOVEMBER 1, 2006 ORDER DIRECTING FILING

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080 and the Order Directing Filing issued by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") on November 1, 2006 in the above-captioned proceeding, Respondent Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL"), hereby notifies the Commission that KCPL contacted Ms. Fabulae but was unable to mutually determine the amount of her electric bill that is not in dispute.¹

- 1. On November 1, 2006, the Commission issued an order directing KCPL and Ms. Fabulae once again "to attempt to mutually determine the amount of Ms. Fabulae's electric bill which is not in dispute as determined pursuant to 4 CSR 240-13.045(5)."
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's order, on November 3, 2006, representatives from KCPL contacted Ms. Fabulae to discuss what portion of her past-due electric bill is not in dispute. KCPL explained that according to its records, Ms. Fabulae currently owes the Company \$3,083.17. KCPL then asked Ms. Fabulae what portion of that amount she would agree is not in dispute.

3. Ms. Fabulae indicated that she believes that she does not owe any of the money that KCPL alleges is due, *i.e.*, that the entire \$3,083.17 is in dispute. She further indicated that although she intends to pay her "monthly" KCPL bills in the future, she does not have any intention of paying the \$3,083.17 that KCPL asserts she owes. KCPL does not agree with Ms. Fabulae's position, and the parties were therefore unable to determine mutually the amount of Ms. Fabulae's electric bill that is not in dispute.

4. Per the Commission's directive, KCPL further provides that the total amount of the charge in dispute is \$3,083.17, and that pursuant to 4 CSR 240-13.045(6) KCPL requests that Ms. Fabulae pay \$1,500, or approximately 50% of the charge in dispute to have her electric service restored pending final resolution of this matter.
