Dear Mr. Hubbs:

This letter is to advise the Commission that AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. ("AT&T") objects to the Stipulation Agreement and Recommendation of United Telephone Company of Missouri, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Office of Public Counsel of the State of Missouri in the above-referenced case. AT&T objects to the Stipulation on the same basis that it objected to a similar stipulation between the Staff and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company -- namely, that the tax savings resulting from the Tax Reform Act of 1986 are proposed to be flowed through only to local exchange service customers, and that access service customers are given none of the benefits of the decrease.
