## STAFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and submits its Recommendation as follows:

- 1. On September 26, 2011, Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) for approval of an amendment to an interconnection agreement with Green Hills Telecommunications Services under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. CenturyLink states that there are no unresolved issues and that the agreement complies with Section 252(e) of the Act in that it is not discriminatory to nonparty carriers and is consistent with the public interest.
- 2. On September 27, 2011, the Commission issued its Order, Directing Notice and Making Green Hills Telecommunications Services a Party, in which it directed Staff to file a memorandum regarding the Application.
- 3. 47 USC 252(e)(2) provides that a state commission may only reject an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation if the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to it or its implementation is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.
- 4. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, Staff states that the amendment to the interconnection agreement does not discriminate against telecommunications

carriers not parties to it, nor is its implementation inconsistent with the public interest, convenience or necessity.

5. Neither Company is delinquent in filing its annual report, or in paying its PSC assessment, or MoUSF and Relay Missouri surcharges.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission approve the Application and direct the parties to submit to the Commission any subsequent modifications or amendments to the Interconnection Agreement.
