STAFF'S MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE INSTANT PROCEEDING WITH STAFF COMPLAINT CASE RESPECTING THE THIRD AND FINAL YEAR OF THE SECOND UE EXPERIMENTAL ALTERNATIVE REGULATION PLAN

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) concurrent with

the filing of its direct testimony and schedules comprising areas of disagreement regarding the

third year of the second Union Electric Company (UE) experimental alternative regulation plan

(EARP) in Case No. EM-96-149 and Complaint Case No. EC-2002-, and requests

consolidation of the two cases for hearing. In support thereof the Staff states that both filings

involve related questions of law and fact and that 4 CSR 240-2.110(3) provides as follows:

When pending actions involve related questions of law or fact, the commission may order a joint hearing of any or all the matters at issue, and may make other orders concerning cases before it to avoid necessary costs or delay.

The Western District Court of Appeals held in State ex rel. Churchill Truck Lines, Inc. v.

Public Serv. Comm'n, 734 S.W.2d 586, 595 (Mo.App. 1987) that the "PSC's discretionary order

of consolidation is clothed with a presumption of validity, and appellant carries a heavy burden

of overcoming that presumption by showing unfairness in the procedure used."

Wherefore the Staff requests that the Commission consolidate Case No. EM-96-149 and the Complaint case, Case No. EC-2000- , that the Staff is filing this date against Union Electric Company relating to the third and final year of the second UE EARP.
