**STATEMENT OF THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS OF  
NON-OPPOSITION TO STIPULATIONS AND AGREEMENTS**

COMES NOW the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (“MIEC”) and for its  
Statement of Non-opposition to Stipulations and Agreements states as follows:

1. On July 22, 2019, a number of the parties to this case filed a First Amended Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement. On July 24, a number of parties filed a Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement as to MSBA Issues.
2. Since not all parties were signatories to either of these agreements, the provisions of 4 CSR 240-2.115 apply. 4 CSR 240-2.115(2)(B) allows a party seven days to object to a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement.
3. The MIEC does not object to the First Amended Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed on July 22.
4. The MIEC does not object to the Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement as to MSBA Issues filed on July 24.
