Dear Mr. Woodruff:

Concurrently with the filing of this letter I am submitting an Application and Motion for Expedited treatment on behalf of my client, Union Electric Company. The Application seeks a waiver of certain tariff provisions and of the Commission's Promotional Practice Rule relating to service to a new subdivision in Cole County. Both the tariff and the Promotional Practices Rule contemplate the availability of a waiver under the circumstances presented; that is, where the area in question is located in an area where there is unregulated competition.

The Commission's rules require all Applications to be verified by an officer of the utility. While Ameren Missouri Vice President Warren Wood has reviewed the Application and has indicated to me that he can verify its facts, he is currently out-of-town and not in a position to sign the required verification in front of a Notary Public. Given that the Application is time-sensitive, I am filing it today, and will submit the signed and notarized verification from Mr. Wood early next week.
