ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME AND SETTING
TIME FOR RESPONSES

On February 22, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion for extension of time to file the report of its investigation in this matter, which is presently due on February 28, 2007. In support of the motion, Staff relates that the Staff member assigned to the case will be out of the office during the week of February 26. Staff requests an extension of time until March 14, 2007, to file its report, in order to allow time for it to review CenturyTel's response and to conduct follow-up, if necessary.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds that it is reasonable to grant Staff the requested extension of time. In addition, the Commission will direct Staff to respond to CenturyTel's motion to dismiss. The Commission will also extend the time for parties to respond to Staff's report.

On February 23, 2007, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, filed its Answer to the complaint. Included with the Answer was a Motion to Dismiss. Christiane Rossetti may file a response to CenturyTel's motion to dismiss as directed below. In her response, Ms. Rossetti should state the reasons she believes her complaint should not be dismissed as requested by CenturyTel. Ms. Rossetti should also send a copy of any response to CenturyTel's attorney, Mr. Larry Dority at 101 Madison, Suite 400, Jefferson City, MO 65101.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file the report of its investigation no later than March 14, 2007.
2. Any party may file a response to Staff's report no later than March 26, 2007.
3. Responses to CenturyTel's Motion to Dismiss may be filed no later than March 26, 2007.
4. This order shall become effective on February 26, 2007.
