**ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR MEDIATION**

On June 8, 2010, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed a complaint against Sprint Spectrum, L.P., d/b/a Sprint PCS, and Nextel West Corp. (collectively, Sprint). On June 11, 2010, the Commission issued notice of the complaint, directed Sprint to respond, and directed its Staff to conduct an investigation. Sprint filed a request for mediation on June 15, 2010. Before proceeding further, the Commission will direct AT&T Missouri to indicate whether it is willing to enter into mediation regarding its complaint.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than June 28, 2010, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, shall file a response to Sprint Spectrum, L.P., d/b/a Sprint PCS, and Nextel West Corp.'s request for mediation, indicating whether it is willing to enter into mediation.

2. The time allowed for Sprint Spectrum, L.P., d/b/a Sprint PCS, and Nextel West Corp. to file a response to this complaint is tolled until Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, has responded to the offer to mediate.

3. The Commission Staff investigation in this matter is suspended until further order of the Commission.

4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
