SPRINT'S RESPONSE TO STAFF'S MOTION TO SUSPEND

COMES NOW Sprint Missouri, Inc and hereby provides its Response to Staff's Motion to Suspend the above mentioned tariff:

1. On June 18, 2004, Sprint Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Sprint ("Sprint") filed a proposed revision to its P.S.C. MO. – No. 22 General Exchange Tariff to introduce 311 Service and 511 Service. The tariff revisions bear an effective date of July 18, 2004.

2. On July 2, 2004, Staff filed its Motion to Suspend Tariff No. JI-2004-1497. Staff stated in its Motion that it needed additional time to complete its review and requested a 60 day suspension.

3. On July 8, 2004, Sprint voluntarily extended the effective date of the tariff by 60 additional days until September 16, 2004 to allow Staff additional time to review Sprint's proposed tariff filing. As such, Staff's request for suspension is moot.

WHEREFORE, Sprint respectfully requests that the Commission consider the above.
