The Commission must find that the grant of service authority is Applications for authority to in the public interest. § 392.440. provide basic local services must comply with § 392.455. Commission may classify a company as competitive if it finds that all the telecommunications services the company offers are competitive § 392.361.3. If the Commission's Staff makes a favorable recommendation and no request for hearing is filed, the Commission may act upon a verified application without hearing. State ex rel. Deffenderfer v. P.S.C., 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989). The Commission ordinarily waives the application of the statutes and Commission rules listed below for competitive companies.
