JOINT RECONCILIATION

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), and respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On October 29, 1999, the City of Rolla, Missouri ("City" or "Rolla") filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") an Application seeking an order, pursuant to Section 386.800 RSMo 1994, designating a specific area as the exclusive electric service territory of the City, and setting fair and reasonable compensation to be paid to Intercounty Electric Cooperative ("Intercounty") as a result of such designation.
- 2. The evidentiary hearing was held on December 4-5, 2000. At the conclusion thereof, the presiding Regulatory Law Judge requested that the Staff file, no later than December 19, 2000, a reconciliation, quantifying the positions of all parties with respect to the question of the appropriate compensation to be paid by Rolla to Intercounty in the event that Rolla's Application is approved.
- 3. Attached hereto as Appendix A is the requested Reconciliation. It is to be noted that the Reconciliation addresses only those issues that one or more of the parties have



quantified. The information was prepared with the assistance of the parties and has been approved by all parties.
