JOINT STATUS REPORT

COME NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), and Aqua Missouri¹ ("the Company") (collectively referred to hereinafter as "the Parties") and submit the following <u>Joint</u> <u>Status Report</u> to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("the Commission"):

1. On December 16, 2009, Staff filed in each of the above-caption matters a pleading informing the Commission that pursuant to negotiations Staff and the Company were able to reach a series of agreements (collectively referred to as "the <u>Company/Staff Disposition</u> <u>Agreements</u>") regarding resolution of the above-captioned revenue increase requests.

¹ "Aqua Missouri," as used in this pleading, shall collectively refer to Aqua RU, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Missouri, Inc., Aqua Missouri, Inc., and Aqua Development Company d/b/a Aqua Missouri, Inc.

2. On February 2, 2010, the Commission issued its <u>Order Setting Deadline for Filing</u> <u>Issues Lists, Witness Lists and Position Statements</u> (Order), ordering the Parties to file by February 24, 2010 certain documents related to the evidentiary hearings scheduled in the abovecaptioned matters, or in the alternative, a joint status report.

3. On February 24, 2010, OPC filed <u>The Office of the Public Counsel's Statement of</u> <u>Position</u>, stating that while OPC will not agree to the proposed rate increases agreed to in the <u>Company/Staff Disposition Agreements</u>, it will not actively oppose their implementation.

4. It appears that at this time evidentiary hearings will not be necessary in these matters. Additionally, absent material information obtained by Staff in its investigation of evidence provided at the local public hearings, the Parties have no further filings to submit to the Commission pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050, the Small Utility Rate Case Procedure.

5. All Parties have reviewed this pleading and consent to Staff's submission thereof.

WHEREFORE, the Parties submit this <u>Joint Status Report</u> for the Commission's consideration and request that the Commission issue an order either affirming the <u>Company/Staff</u> <u>Disposition Agreements</u> filed in the above-captioned matters, or in the alternative, staying the procedural schedule, canceling the evidentiary hearings scheduled for March 1-12, 2010, and establishing such additional procedures as the Commission deems appropriate.
