The Commission opened this case on February 21, 2018 to consider the propriety of the natural gas rates charged by The Empire District Gas Company in light of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017. The Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG), the Missouri School Boards' Association (MSBA), and Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed timely applications to intervene.
