ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On July 17, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting US Cable Telecom of Missouri, L.L.C.'s, ("US Cable") certificates of service authority and accompanying tariffs to provide basic local telecommunications services and interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted US Cable these certificates in File Number LA-2007-0453.

The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days, excluding weekends and holidays, from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
