Dear Staff:

On November 12, 2009 the Commission granted Joint Application File No. TO-2010-0117 and approved the substitute tariff sheets filed on November 5, 2009. The effective date on those tariff sheets is November 13, 2009. However, the transaction whereby Comcast Phone will acquire the customer accounts of CIMCO in the state of Missouri has not yet been consummated. The transaction will not close until all regulatory approvals are obtained. While most state approvals have been received, the parties do not expect to receive approval from the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") until the middle of February 2010, at the earliest.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> On October 7, 2009, Comcast and CIMCO filed with the FCC an application pursuant to section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, seeking approval of the transfer of certain CIMCO assets and authorizations to Comcast. The FCC issued a Public Notice on December 1, 2009 establishing a 60-day pleading cycle for the proceeding, which commences on the day that all affected local franchise authorities ("LFAs") acknowledge receipt of the Public Notice. Closing will not occur before the completion of the pleading cycle and it is not known when the FCC will issue any order in the proceeding. *See Applications Filed for the Acquisition of Certain Assets and Authorizations of CIMCO Communications, Inc. by Comcast Phone, LLC, Comcast Phone of Michigan, LLC and Comcast Business Communications, LLC*, Public Notice, WC Docket No. 09-183, FCC No. 09-104 (rel. Dec. 1, 2009).
