I am sending this letter in response to the comments you submitted regarding the above-referenced subject. Please be advised that the rate increase request you commented upon is simply that, a request by the Company. A rate increase will not occur unless the Commission approves one, and that will not happen unless the Staff of the Commission has submitted a recommendation for approval of an increase to the Commission.

The Staff is currently auditing the Company's books and records to determine if it believes a rate increase is warranted. The Staff is also conducting reviews of the Company's service charges and connection fees, the Company's operation of its utility facilities, the Company's business operations and the Company's tariff provisions to see if any changes regarding those matters are warranted. When the Staff's audit and reviews are completed, the Staff will work with the Company, and the Office of the Public Counsel, in an attempt to reach an agreement regarding the Company's request.

If at least the Staff and the Company reach an agreement regarding the Company's request, proposed tariff revisions, a written agreement and a Staff recommendation for approval of the tariff revisions and the agreement will be submitted to the Commission for its consideration. Depending on whether the Public Counsel joins in the agreement, if one is reached, a notice regarding the results of the agreement may or may not be sent to the Company's customers. If an agreement regarding the Company's request is not reached between at least the Staff and the Company, no rate increase will occur.

Thank you for taking the time to submit your comments regarding the Company's request, and again please note that a rate increase will not occur unless the Commission approves one.
