Dear Judge Thompson:

As ordered in the hearing on this matter held September 28, 2005, Verizon Wireless submits the following responses to the questions posed by Commissioner Gaw at said hearing:

- Q. For purposes of determining whether a call from a landline customer in the Savannah exchange to a wireless customer whose business or residence address is in the Savannah exchange, is the determination of whether the call is treated as local or toll based upon the NPA (area code) of the called and calling telephone numbers or the NXX (prefix) of the called and calling telephone numbers?
- A. It is not based on the NPA of either number, but whether such a call is to be treated as local or toll is determined solely by the local exchange carrier serving the Savannah exchange.
- Q. If a landline customer in the Savannah exchange calls a wireless customer whose business or residence address is in the Savannah exchange, will that call be treated as a local call or a toll call?
- A. There is no definitive answer to this question. The determination of whether this call is treated as local or toll is made solely by the local exchange carrier serving the Savannah exchange.
- Q. Is it possible for a wireless carrier to get a number rated out of the Savannah exchange?

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A. Yes. However, Verizon Wireless does not have any numbers rated out of the Savannah rate center.
