NALA/PCA'S REPLY TO NOW COMMUNICATION, INC.'S RESPONSE TO SPRINT'S MOTION FOR JOINDER OF PARTIES

Comes Now National ALEC Association/Prepaid Communications Association ("NALA/PCA") by and through counsel and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080 (15), and files this Reply to the Response of NOW Communications, Inc., filed on or about April 2, 2003, to Sprint's Motion for Joinder of Parties in this case of March 17, 2003. NALA/PCA continues to strongly oppose Sprint's Motion for Joinder of Parties and in support of its position states as follows:

1. NALA/PCA observes with interest the recitation by NOW Communications, Inc. that: "As NOW is no longer a member of NALA/PCA, Sprint does not object to removing NOW from the Motion for Joinder." This is further, clear evidence that Sprint's real interest in "joining" the Missouri members of NALA/PCA as individual parties to this docket is to seek retribution for NALA's intervention and to increase their costs, as suggested in the Response filed by NALA/PCA on March 28 in this matter.

- 2. Sprint is apparently willing to excuse NOW Communications, one of the few carriers actually doing some business in Sprint territory in Missouri, but continues to seek joinder of the company-members of NALA/PCA, most of whom do no business in Sprint territory at the present time. This further demonstrates that there is no independent, objective reason for joinder of these particular companies as individual parties.
- The fundamental fact is that neither NOW Communications, nor the Missouri member-companies of NALA/PCA, should be joined as individual parties to this proceeding, nor has Sprint offered any reason why they should be.
- 4. The Commission should conclude, as NALA/PCA has previously stated, that absolutely no justification or authority has been provided by Sprint in support of its request to forcibly join additional CLECs as individual parties to this case merely by virtue of their membership in an association which has intervened as an association, namely NALA/PCA.

WHEREFORE, NALA/PCA respectfully requests that the Commission deny Sprint's Motion for Joinder of Parties in this case.
