## NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL OF TARIFF AND NOTICE CLOSING CASE

On March 8, 2011, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed a motion to suspend a tariff of IntelePeer Inc. (Tariff File No. YL-2011-0406). AT&T Missouri believed the tariff would modify existing intrastate switched access tariff provisions and that the tariff was vague, ambiguous, and should be clarified. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission supported the suspension. The tariff filing carried a proposed effective date of March 13, 2011, which the Commission suspended to May 12, 2011.

On April 7, 2011, IntelePeer withdrew Tariff File No. YL-2011-0406. Since the tariff originally proposed for Commission consideration has been withdrawn, nothing further remains for decision by the Commission, and this case shall be closed.
