ORDER ADOPTING STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS AND ESTABLISHING ACA BALANCE

Issue Date: June 18, 2009 Effective Date: June 28, 2009

This case was opened to receive the 2007-2008 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing of Missouri Gas Utility, Inc. On May 5, 2009, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation and memorandum indicating that Staff has completed an analysis and evaluation of billed revenues and actual gas costs for the period September 1, 2007, through August 31, 2008, included in Missouri Gas Utility's computation of its ACA rate. Staff also conducted a reliability analysis and a hedging review for Missouri Gas Utility. In addition, Staff reviewed Missouri Gas Utility's gas purchasing practices to determine the prudence of its purchasing decisions.

Staff did not recommend that the Commission make any adjustments to the company's ACA account balances. However, Staff recommended that Missouri Gas Utility take several actions regarding the company's hedging practices, reliability analysis and gas supply planning, monitoring of its ACA balance, and tariff modifications relating to billing error adjustments.

On May 11, the Commission directed Missouri Gas Utility to respond to Staff's recommendations by June 10. Missouri Gas Utility filed its response on June 10, indicating

that it accepts Staff's recommendations.

After reviewing Staff's recommendations and Missouri Gas Utility's response, the Commission concludes that Missouri Gas Utility shall implement Staff's recommendations.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Missouri Gas Utility, Inc. shall establish the following ACA account balance in its next ACA filing to reflect the August 31, 2008 (over)/under-recovered ACA balance:
