## ORDER RESCINDING ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY OUT OF TIME

On October 19, 2009<sup>1</sup>, Midwest Gas Users' Association (hereafter "MGUA") filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider and rescind its order granting MGE leave to file a witness' surrebuttal testimony out of time. MGUA also filed a motion for expedited treatment.

The Commission will grant MGUA's motion and rescind the previously described order. Further, the Commission's October 20 Order Directing Filing is also rescinded, as it was issued in response to MGUA's motion. Because MGUA's motion is granted, responses are no longer required.<sup>2</sup>

Because the above-described order is rescinded, MGE's motion for leave to file surrebuttal testimony out of time remains pending.
