## ORDER DIRECTING ADJUSTMENT OF ACA BALANCE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is ordering Summit Natural Gas, ("the Company") to comply with the suggestions in Staff's recommendation<sup>1</sup> and Staff's reply, <sup>2</sup> including adjustments to the Company's actual cost adjustment balances for the 2011-2012 period ("ACA") for its Northern and Southern systems, as follows.

On July 24, 2013, Staff filed the recommendation. On August 26, 2013, the Company filed a response to the recommendation,<sup>3</sup> alleging that the Company has

already complied with some of Staff's suggestions, and agreeing with other suggestions. Staff filed the reply on September 4, 2013.

The Company and Staff agree on the adjustments to the Company's ACA balances and other matters related to the ACA. No hearing is required<sup>4</sup> to make an unopposed<sup>5</sup> order, so this action is not a contested case,<sup>6</sup> and the Commission need not separately state its findings of fact. The absence of opposition also constitutes good cause for the Commission to make this order effective in less than 30 days,<sup>7</sup> so the Commission will order the following.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Summit Natural Gas shall adjust its actual cost adjustment balances for the 2011-2012 period as set forth in the body of this order.
- 2. Summit Natural Gas shall otherwise comply with the suggestions as set forth in Staff Recommendation Regarding the Summit Natural Gas of Missouri's 2011-2012 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA).
