**ORDER DENYING APPLICATIONS FOR REHEARING AND
NOTICE OF CORRECTION NUNC PRO TUNC**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is denying *Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing*¹ and *Missouri School Boards' Application for Rehearing*² ("motions"). The standard under which the Commission determines whether to grant a rehearing is whether "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear."³ The pending motions do not show sufficient reason for a rehearing, so the Commission will deny the motions.

The Commission is also giving notice that the Commission is correcting the *Report and Order*⁴ nunc pro tunc⁵ at page 17, Finding of Fact 4, second line, by deleting the word "originally" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "currently." That correction accurately reflects the record as cited.⁶ That finding of fact was not the sole basis of any conclusion of law, so all conclusions of law and ordered paragraphs remain unaltered by that correction.
