- The Missouri Department of Natural Resources was created under authority of Article IV, sections 12 and 47 of the Constitution of the State of Missouri to administer programs of the State relating to environmental control and the conservation and management of natural resources.
- 3. In order to effect the mandace of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of Missouri the Division of Policy Development was created which, through the Missouri Energy Program, is empowered to manage effectively State energy supply and distribution problems pursuant to an Executive Order of November 8, 1977. Moreover, the Air Pollution Control Program of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources is staffed with specialists in the area of design, operation, and maintenance of electrical power generating facilities.
- 4. The application of Union Electric Company proposes that the company construct, operate, and maintain two oil-fired combustion turbine generating units on a site located at Union



Electric Company's Meramec power plant property at 8200 Fine Road, St. Louis County, Missouri.

- 5. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources seeks participation without intervention in an effort to determine the convenience and necessity of installing two oil-fired combustion turbine generating units in light of load forecasts and general energy conservation concerns, as well as in an effort to explore alternative measures such as demand limiting and redistribution or power generation through other energy sources.
- 6. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources requests leave to participate without intervention to the following degree: To be served with copies of the case papers including, but not limited to, all pleadings, transcripts, prefiled testimony and exhibits.

WHEREFORE the Missouri Department of Natural Resources requests that the Commission enter an order granting its application for leave to participate without intervention to the degree described herein.
