On August 8, 2008, Northeast Missouri Rural Telephone Company filed a pleading entitled Motion for an Order Permitting Northeast to file Motion for Summary Disposition with Highly Confidential Designation. By Commission rule, AT&T Corporation's response to that motion is due no later than August 18. On August 14, AT&T filed a motion asking that it be allowed until August 22 to file a response. AT&T's motion represents that Northeast Missouri Rural Telephone Company does not oppose this request.

The motion for extension of time is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant the motion.
