COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

1. On May 4, 2010, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T") filed a request to be relieved from its commitments to make a cost allocation manual filing and to submit surveillance report data.

2. Those commitments were made to the Staff when AT&T was under rate-of-return regulation. These commitments are no longer necessary since AT&T is no longer under rate-of-return regulation and is currently classified as a competitive telecommunications company. The Staff, including the Utility Operations Staff and the Utility Services Staff, agree AT&T should be relieved of those obligations.

3. AT&T is currently compliant in obligations relating to Commission assessment, Missouri Universal Service Fund, Relay Missouri, and the submission of an annual report.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff recommends that the Commission grant AT&T's request to be relieved of its commitments to file a cost allocation manual and submit surveillance report data.
