Order and MGE's Motion For Expedited Treatment

DATE: January 24, 2006

On January 20, 2006, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE), a division of Southern Union Company, filed a tariff sheet with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) with a proposed effective date of February 19, 2006. In addition, MGE filed a Motion For Expedited Treatment (Motion) relating to this filing on the same day. The Motion requested an effective date of January 29, 2006. On January 20, 2006, the Commission issued an ORDER DIRECTING FILING that directed the Staff to file its recommendation, or indicate a date that a recommendation could be filed on January 24, 2006.

This tariff sheet complies with the Commission's Order (Order) dated January 19, 2006, authorizing MGE to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS) sufficient to recover an annual pre-tax revenue of \$2,388,000 as computed by the Commission's Energy-Tariff/Rate Design Staff (Staff). The methodology used to generate this version ISRS rates is consistent with Staff's proposed methodology and past practice.

The Staff has reviewed MGE's tariff sheet and MGE's Motion. The Staff's analysis indicates that the tariff sheet was filed in compliance with the Commission's January 19 Order in this case. Staff raises no objection to the expedited effective date of January 29, 2006.

The Staff has verified that the Company has filed its annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. The Staff has reviewed this filing and is not aware of any issue currently pending before the Commission that affects, or is affected by, this filing.
