On June 29, 2006, MGE filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2005, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for mains, valves, service lines, regulator stations, vaults, and other pipeline system components. On September 21, 2006, the Commission approved an ISRS for MGE; however, the Commission rejected the tariff that MGE filed, and allowed MGE to instead file a tariff that comports with the Staff's Recommendation and with the Commission's order.

On September 22, MGE filed a tariff with an effective date of October 22. In addition, MGE filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment, asking the Commission to approve the tariff no later than October 2. The Commission will order its Staff to file either a Recommendation or a pleading that states when it will file its Recommendation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation or, in the alternative, a pleading stating when it plans to file its Recommendation, no later than September 26, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on September 22, 2006.
