**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH**  
**COMMISSION ORDER**

Issue Date: January 14, 2008

Effective Date: January 23, 2008

In its Order Approving Adjusted ISRS rates, issued on January 8, 2008, the Commission authorized Missouri Gas Energy (MGE), a division of Southern Union Company to file a tariff implementing an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge sufficient to recover appropriate pre-tax revenues in the amount of \$1,339,878. MGE issued the required tariff on January 8, with a 30-day effective date of February 7. Along with its tariff, MGE submitted a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff to become effective on January 23.

Staff filed its recommendation regarding MGE's tariff on January 11. Staff indicates that the tariff complies with the Commission's Order, and recommends the Commission approve the tariff to become effective on January 23. No other party has filed a recommendation.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines the tariff complies with the Commission's Order. The Commission also finds good cause to

approve the tariff to be effective in less than 30 days. The Commission will approve the tariff effective January 23.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The following tariff issued January 8, 2008, and assigned Tariff No. YG-2008-0419, is approved to become effective on January 23, 2008:
