ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW AND SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

On May 5, 2010, the Director of Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint against 5 Star Homes and Development Company, Inc. After being notified of the complaint, 5 Star Homes filed a response. However, the response was not filed by an attorney. The Commission, therefore, notified 5 Star Homes that because it is a corporation, it must be represented by an attorney. The Commission then set the matter for a prehearing conference.

The company made no appearance at the prehearing conference, after which the Commission issued an order directing 5 Star to show good cause for its failure to appear and why the Commission should not issue an order in default.

The company responded through an attorney, Derek Thrasher, who filed an answer.

Later, however, Mr. Thrasher sought leave to withdraw; stating only that his client consented to such withdrawal. Because Mr. Thrasher's client consents to his withdrawal.

the Commission will grant that relief. However, in order to resolve this case without delay, the Commission will set this matter for an evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Derek Thrasher's motion to withdraw as 5 Star Homes and Development Company, Inc.'s attorney is granted.
- 2. An evidentiary hearing shall be held at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305, on November 9, 2010, beginning at 10:00 a.m. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
