1 JUDGE CLARK: Good morning. Today's date is  
2 June 11th, 2018, and the time is currently 10:15. This  
3 prehearing was scheduled to start at 10:00. 15 minutes  
4 were given for the Respondent to show up. As of right  
5 now the Respondent, Michael Goodwin, nor his attorney,  
6 Andrew Westerfeld, have appeared so far either in person  
7 or telephonically.

8 The Commission has set aside this time for a  
9 prehearing conference on the case captioned as The  
10 Director of Manufactured Homes and Modular Units Program  
11 of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Complainant,  
12 versus Michael Goodwin, Respondent, File Number  
13 MC-2018-0236.

14 My name is John Clark. I'm the regulatory  
15 law judge assigned to this matter. We're in Room 305 of  
16 the Governor Office Building.

17 And we'll begin by having the attorneys who  
18 are present enter their appearance, starting with the  
19 attorneys for the Director of Manufactured Homes.

20 MS. KLAUS: Alexandra Klaus on behalf of the  
21 Complainant. My information's been provided to the  
22 reporter.

23 MR. JOHNSON: Mark Johnson on behalf of the  
24 Complainant, and I've also provided my information to the  
25 court reporter.

1 JUDGE CLARK: Also present today are Justin  
2 Smith, the Director of Manufactured Homes, as well as  
3 Jamie Meyers. No one from the Office of the Public  
4 Counsel is present.

5 Normally this is the part where I would say  
6 failure to appear without having previously secured a  
7 continuance shall constitute grounds for dismissal; but  
8 it's your complaint, so that would not make any sense.

9 It's obvious that I'm not Dan Jordan. Judge  
10 Jordan has retired, and this case was passed off to me.  
11 I'm not 100 percent sure why he scheduled this prehearing  
12 conference so early prior to anything really being due on  
13 this case. I assume that he had scheduled it to give the  
14 parties an opportunity to talk to each other, but one  
15 party has chosen not to avail themselves of that.

16 With that in mind, are there any preliminary  
17 motions or matters?

18 MS. KLAUS: No.

19 JUDGE CLARK: All right. There's really  
20 nothing for us to talk about here. So I think what's  
21 going to happen is I'm going to issue a show cause as to  
22 why default should not be granted to Mr. Goodwin and his  
23 attorney and see if that appropriately gets their  
24 attention.

25 Are there any other matters or anything else

1 that needs to be addressed by the Commission at this  
2 time?

3 MR. JOHNSON: No, Judge.

4 MS. KLAUS: No, Judge.

5 JUDGE CLARK: In that case, we will adjourn,  
6 and we'll go off the record.
