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JUDGE GRAHAM: We're on the record. The date is 1 2 January 14th, 2020, 10:00 a.m. The Commission has set this time at this place for a procedural conference in the case caption 3 The Manager of the Manufactured Homes and Modular Units Program 4 of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Complainant versus 5 6 Charles W. Brune and Anna G. Brune doing business as Brune 7 Mobile Sales, Respondent. The file Number MC-2020-0135. 8 My name is Paul Gray and I'm the regulatory 9 judge -- or the regulatory law judge in this matter. I'm going 10 to ask Ms. Klaus to go ahead and enter her appearance on behalf 11 of the commission staff. 12 MS. KLAUS: Thank you, Judge. On behalf of the 13 Manager, Alexandra Klaus. 14 JUDGE GRAHAM: Okay. I'm going to let the 15 record reflect that no attorney is present for Charles W. Brune 16 or Anna G. Brune, doing business as Brune Mobile Sales, the 17 respondent in this case. While we were off the record we did 18 endeavor -- Staff counsel, Ms. Klaus, did endeavor to reach 19 Mr. Brady, Thad Brady, who has entered his appearance in this 20 case or filed an answer, one or the -- well, he's filed an 21 answer. I don't recall whether he entered his appearance. 22 He's filed an answer on behalf of the 23 respondents and so he's the counsel of record. We did endeavor 24 to reach him. Let the record reflect that he is not here nor 2.5 are the respondents here. We did call him and we did leave him

What we're going to do is simply adjourn this hearing. I'll decide what order to enter with respect to what has occurred today after -- or the Commission will, I should say, after the Commission has had time to reflect upon these matters.

In the meantime, Ms. Klaus, I'm not sure without checking the rule whether it is imperative that we actually conduct a procedural conference on the record. What I'm getting at is this: I'm not particularly interested in making this an event. There's any number of explanations for this. We don't need to make this an event if it's not really an event. What I would suggest that you do is call Mr. Brady, have the Staff call Mr. Brady on this. And if you guys should come up with a procedural schedule by agreement, we'll take a look at that and maybe we can just go right by today's events and end up with a procedural schedule and take it from there. I say that with this caveat: I'm not sure whether we have to do this on the record. I'm just not sure of that.

But I'm inviting you, if you wish, I'm not going to tell you how to do your case or anything like that -- but I'm inviting you, if you wish, to go ahead and reach out to him and see what we can do about just moving on with the case and getting ourselves a procedural order.
