The Commission must find that the grant of service authority is in the public interest. Section 392.440. Applications for authority to provide basic local services must comply with Section 392.455. The Commission may classify a company as competitive if it finds that all the telecommunications services the company offers are competitive services. Section 392.361.3. The Commission ordinarily waives the application of the statutes and Commission rules listed below for competitive companies.
