On November 25, 2015, Alliance Connect, LLC (Alliance) filed an application with the Commission for certificates of service to provide basic local exchange, non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri. It also asks that those services and the company be classified as competitive. Alliance is an lowa limited liability company, with its principal place of business at 7760 Office Plaza Drive South, West Des Moines, Iowa 50266. Alliance did not file tariffs with its application, but will maintain a publically accessible website identifying retail prices for its services. It intends to file a proposed access services tariff as soon as practicable after filing its application.

The Commission will direct its Data Center to send notice as set out in the ordered paragraphs below. The Commission will also set a deadline for any applications to intervene, and will direct the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation.

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice of this application to all telecommunications carriers certificated to operate in the state of Missouri.

2. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than December 15, 2015.

3. No later than December 22, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation regarding the application.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
