ORDER AND NOTICE

On November 30, 2004, MCC Telephony of Missouri, Inc., asked the Commission for a certificate of service authority to provide telecommunications service. Some of the parties entered into a Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement.

The Commission has questions about the agreement. On April 27, the Commission ordered the parties to appear at the Commission's May 3 Agenda meeting to answer Commissioners' questions.

The next day, MCC Telephony's counsel filed a Motion to Reschedule Agenda Appearance. MCC Telephony's counsel has a conflict, and asks the Commission to allow the parties to appear at the May 5 Agenda meeting instead.

The Commission will grant the motion. The Commission will order the parties to answer Commissioners' questions at the Commission's May 5 Agenda meeting.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the parties appear and answer the Commission's questions at the Commission's May 5, 2005 Agenda meeting, scheduled for 9:30 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 200 Madison, Jefferson City, Missouri.
2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 2005.
