On May 19, 2008, Laclede Gas Company filed a proposed tariff revision to allow Laclede to estimate the usage on a customer's natural gas bill whenever an automatic meter reader (AMR) fails to transmit an actual reading. The proposed revision also contains notice requirements in the event Laclede's meter or AMR is defective. The tariff revision was assigned Tariff No. YG-2008-0690 and bears an effective date of September 16, 2008.

On May 28, 2008, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion to suspend this tariff filing and a request for an evidentiary hearing. In accordance with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15), responses to this pleading shall be filed as set out below.
