## ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO POSTPONE EVIDENTIARY HEARING

Issue Date: November 23, 2010 Effective Date: November 23, 2010

The Commission set an evidentiary hearing for November 29, 2010. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") filed a request to postpone the hearing. Ameren Missouri has withdrawn the tariff that was in dispute and states there is approximately \$100,000 of additional funding available for its "Missouri Energy Efficient Natural Gas Equipment and Building Shell Measure Rebate Program". Additionally, the Residential and Commercial Customer Energy Efficiency Collaborative (composed of the parties to this action) will be meeting next week and may be able to resolve any issues concerning revising the tariff to use these funds for customer rebates.

The Commission finds Ameren Missouri's request to be reasonable and will grant it. The Commission will set a deadline for a status report and new hearing date.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The evidentiary hearing set for November 29, 2010 is canceled.

2. No later than December 21, 2010, the parties shall file a status report explaining, with particularity, if agreement has been reached on revising the tariff implementing the Missouri Energy Efficient Natural Gas Equipment and Building Shell Measure Rebate

Program. If agreement has not been reached, the parties shall state, with particularity, what issues are in dispute. If no issues are in dispute the parties shall affirmatively so state.

3. An evidentiary hearing is set for December 30, 2010 at 8:30 a.m. If the members of the Collaborative resolve the issues concerning the rebate program prior to the hearing, the hearing will be canceled.

4. The evidentiary hearing, if held, will be held in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
