**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On November 9, 2011<sup>1</sup>, Southern Union Company d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE") filed a tariff that would allow it to implement an Experimental Pilot program called the "Rebuild Joplin Program". That tariff bears an effective date of December 9.

On November 30, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion to Suspend Tariff. Because the tariff effective date is only nine days away, the Commission must order MGE and Staff to respond expeditiously.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy and the Staff of the Commission shall respond to the Motion to Suspend Tariff no later than December 2, 2011.
