## ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSES

On December 18, 2019, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed a revised tariff sheet to change the current requirement of Spire East to release Mississippi River Transmission capacity to the schools as part of its tariffed school transportation program. The tariff sheet bears an effective date of January 17, 2020. Due to concerns that this may create a preference for gas marketers to request the release of pipeline capacity at the expense of Spire's Purchased Gas Adjustment customers, the Staff of the Commission asks the Commission to suspend the tariff sheet 120 days to allow Staff to investigate.

The Commission will order Spire to respond and set a deadline for any other comments.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire shall respond to the Staff of the Commission's request to suspend the tariff sheet no later than January 6, 2020.
- 2. Any party wanting to comment on Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire's response or Spire's tariff sheet shall do so no later than January 9, 2020.

## 3. This order is effective when issued.
